#### 1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of accounts:

The financial statements of the charity have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### **Funds**

Restricted funds comprise donations or grants which may only be used for specific purposes as laid down by the donor. Unrestricted funds are general funds which may be used for any purpose within the charitable objectives of the PCC.

### Income and expenditure:

Income and expenditure is accounted for in the year for which the income is received and in which the expenditure is incurred.

## 2 LAND AT ST MARK'S

Widcombe PCC owns a piece of land by St Mark's Community Centre. The PCC is currently negotiating the possibility of a sale of this land with interested parties.
